#### ***Seminar Purpose***

The Kansas City-St. Louis Training Seminar is a professional seminar in analytical psychology designed for specialized enrichment or analytical training. The seminar is based on a four year curriculum, which may be entered at any point in the cycle, and attended for one or more years. Seminars are held once a month on Friday evening and all day Saturday, usually meeting the second weekend of the month (September through December and February through May). The seminar site alternates between Kansas City, KS and St. Louis, MO, depending on teaching faculty. Participation in the seminar assumes travel to each location to attend all classes.

The seminar, consisting of courses and case colloquia, is taught by Analysts of The Kansas City-St. Louis Seminar and visiting International Association of Analytical Psychology (IAAP) faculty. Course material reflects broad and diverse theoretical perspectives. Exploring analytical psychology from classical, clinical, archetypal, and developmental perspectives, participants in this program are offered an opportunity to develop their knowledge of Jungian theory and practice. Case colloquia are conducted on Friday evenings, while Saturdays offer courses. It is possible to attend Saturdays only.

The Kansas City-St. Louis Training Seminar is also an approved training seminar of Inter-Regional Society of Jungian Analysts (IRSJA), providing required didactic instruction and evaluation for those who wish to apply for and are accepted into training as a Jungian analyst. However, as stated above, the seminar welcomes those who may not be interested in training but would find such an engagement stimulating and profitable for personal reasons.

#### ***Application Procedure***

Evaluations for prospective applicants to Kansas City-St. Louis Training seminars are held in August. Please fill out the application enclosed and mail or fax or e-mail to training coordinator

Lucy Sikes. You will receive a phone call to set up informal phone interviews with two of the seminar analysts. These interviews are designed to let us know a little about who you are, and for you to ask questions that would help you make a decision about participating in the seminar.

If you are interested in possibly training as an analyst, attendance in an IRSJA seminar, such as Kansas City-St. Louis, is required for a minimum of six months before application is made to the IRSJA. More detailed information about training is available from training coordinator Lucy Sikes.

### Case Colloquia

The Friday evening case colloquium is most important for integrating theory and practice, as this provides an opportunity to see how Jungian theory is applied in the lives of actual persons who come into analysis. Cases are presented either by the instructing analyst or by a candidate in training

### Seminar Facilities:

West: When in the Kansas City area, we meet in a centrally located office building in Overland Park, Kansas. This is on an easy access route from the Kansas City (MO) airport, about 35 minutes away.

East: When in the St. Louis, Missouri area, we meet at Eden Seminary, Webster Grove, room TBA

### Tuition

Full participants pay \$1,600 per year which is due September 1st. Tuition may be paid in two installments, with half due September 1<sup>st</sup> and half due January 10<sup>th</sup>.

If you attend Saturday only, tuition is \$1,200 per year, and may also be paid in two installments with the same due dates.
